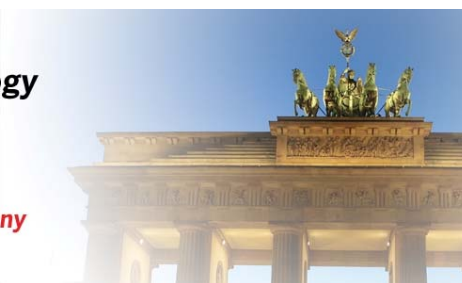

Cleaning Services

All material, including scenery, drapes, signs used in the construction of an exhibit booth must be flame-retardant and have to conform to the German Fire and Police Regulations.

Exhibits with enclosed ceilings are not permitted, nor are double-deck booths, helium balloons and / or signs obstructing the sprinkler systems and / or the smoke detector systems and emergency exit signs.

All main and cross aisles, corridors, stairways and other exit areas must maintain the required width of 2 meters during show hours.

All fire hose cabinets, fire extinguishers, pull stations and emergency exits must be visible and accessible at all times. It is unlawful to lock or fasten any door or other means of exit.

Exhibit floorplan have to be submitted to the hotel and conference organizers for approval.

Damage / Insurance

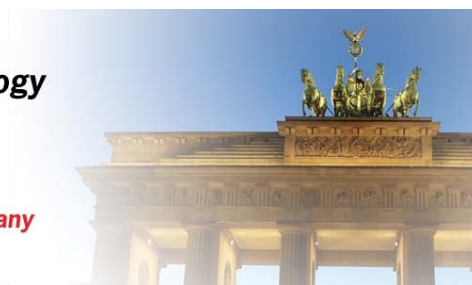

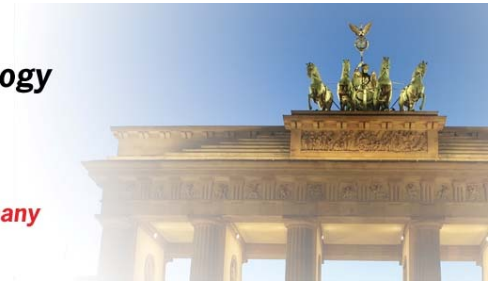
