His dental research works are in the field of bleaching materials and their effect on tooth substance. He is an active member of several international dental professional organizations. He maintains a private practice limited to prosthodontics and aesthetic dentistry in Tel Aviv, Israel.

Dr. Smidt had served as the Editor of The Israel Society of Prosthodontics, and as the President of the Society and became Immediate Past president in March 2000.

Dr. Smidt has published many articles in the international dental literature and serves as a member of the editorial board of several international dental journals. Dr. smidt has given numerous lectures related to Orthodontics as an adjunct for higher quality and esthetic results in Oral Rehabilitation, aesthetics in dentistry and aesthetics using dental implants at international meetings.
